

Directions to the Knight Center and the Department of Economics (Seigle Hall room 307)

The following maps show directions on how to get to the Department of Economics/Seigle Hall and the Knight Center. The maps are ordered from the largest area to the smallest. For example, the first map shows a large radius around Washington University and surrounding highways, while the last map shows only the section of the Washington University campus that includes the Seigle Hall and the Knight Center. Seigle Hall is between the Knight Center and Olin Business School. Seigle Hall and Olin Business School are both adjacent to the football field. Directions from the Airport

By taxi: Cab fare is approximately \$30 each way. For reservations, call County Cab at 314-991-5300.

By car: Drive time from the airport to the Washington University campus is about 30 minutes. For driving directions, see below.

Directions via Metrolink

Via MetroLink: For \$3, you can take the light-rail system to the University City/Big Bend Station. After exiting the train, take the elevator or stairs to street level. Washington University's Danforth campus is on the southeast corner (Big Bend and Forest Park Parkway). Please visit <http://www.metrostlouis.org/> for additional information.

- How to get from the airport to the Knight Center via MetroLink: The main terminal at Lambert Airport is at the west end of a line, the east terminal the second to last stop. Take the line east bound toward the city and get off at DeBaliviere, the change point. Cross the platform and take a train west bound for Shrewsbury/I-44 (*NOT for Lambert*). Get off at Big Bend station. This station is at the northwest corner of campus. If you are turned around, you will see a big sign for the University at this northwest corner. The Knight Center is one block south and one block east from the station. You can also use this station to get a direct train to downtown (east bound).
- To reach the Knight Center, walk east on Forest Park Parkway and turn right on Throop Drive. The Knight Center is straight ahead, and has a half-circle drive in front.
- To reach Seigle Hall, walk east on Forest Park Parkway and turn right on Throop Drive. The Knight Center is straight ahead. Walk past the Knight Center on the right up the stairs and follow the sidewalk across the parking area. Seigle Hall is directly ahead on the right, adjacent to the football field. The Department of Economics is on the south end (closest to the football field and furthest from the Knight Center) of the third floor.

Driving Directions to Seigle Hall - Department of Economics

From I-70 (or Lambert International Airport)

- Go south on I-170 to the Forest Park Parkway exit.
- Go east on Forest Park Parkway through Clayton, to Big Bend Boulevard.
- Turn right (south) onto Big Bend Boulevard and continue for approximately .5 miles.
- Turn left (east) onto Forsyth. The Washington University campus will be on your left.
- Turn left at the first campus driveway (Olympian Way) which is just past Francis field.
- Seigle Hall is straight ahead by the circular portion of the driveway (Olympian Way). Seigle Hall faces Mudd Field (open grassy area), and sits adjacent to the football field.

From I-64 (Hwy 40), heading west (from downtown St. Louis)

- Take the Skinker/Clayton Road exit and turn right (north) onto Skinker Boulevard (the cross street at the end of the exit ramp).
- Travel north on Skinker Boulevard for approximately .8 of a mile.
- Turn left (west) on Forsyth.
- Continue west on Forsyth for approximately .5 of a mile.
- Turn right at the campus driveway, Olympian Way.
- Seigle Hall is straight ahead by the circular portion of the driveway (Olympian Way)

From I-64 (Hwy 40), heading east (from west county)

- Take the North Hanley Road exit and go north on Hanley Road. Continue to Clayton Road.
- Turn right (east) onto Clayton Road. Continue on Clayton to Big Bend Boulevard.
- Turn left (north) onto Big Bend Boulevard. Continue to the second stop light at Forsyth.
- Turn right (east) onto Forsyth.
- Continue east on Forsyth to first stop light.
- Turn left at the campus driveway, Olympian Way.
- Simon Hall is straight ahead by the circular portion of the driveway (Olympian Way).

Driving Directions to the Charles F. Knight Executive Education Center

The Charles F. Knight Center is located on the north side of the Danforth Campus at Forest Park Parkway and Throop Drive, one block east of Big Bend Blvd. Please park in the garage located just across Throop Drive from the Charles F. Knight Center.

From I-70 (or Lambert International Airport)

- Go south on I-170 to the Forest Park Parkway exit.
- Go east on Forest Park Parkway through Clayton, past Big Bend Boulevard to Throop Drive (first stoplight after Big Bend).
- Turn right (south) onto Throop Drive.

From I-64 (Hwy 40), heading west (from downtown St. Louis)

- Take the Skinker/Clayton Road exit and turn right onto Skinker Boulevard (the cross street at the end of the exit ramp).
- Go north on Skinker Boulevard for approximately .9 miles.
- Turn left (west) onto Forest Park Parkway. Continue on Forest Park Parkway to Throop Drive.
- Turn left (south) onto Throop Drive.

From I-64 (Hwy 40), heading east (from west county)

- Take the North Hanley Road exit and go north on Hanley Road. Continue to Clayton Road.
- Turn right (east) onto Clayton Road. Continue on Clayton to Big Bend Boulevard.
- Turn left (north) onto Big Bend Boulevard. Continue to the third stop light at Forest Park Parkway.
- Turn right (east) on Forest Park Parkway. Continue to the first stop light, Throop Drive.
- Turn right (south) onto Throop Drive.
