Basic Study Abroad Requirements

Approved programs were chosen for their high academic quality and suitability for the curriculum and educational priorities of Washington University.

You must have a **minimum 3.0 GPA**.*

In order to earn WU credit for summer programs, you must **apply through the Overseas Programs office**. Exceptions are listed in the box on the right.

Check with the Study Abroad Advisor in your department or on the “Choose by Interest” drop-down menu on the Overseas Programs website if you wish to receive major/minor credit.

You may petition to participate in an alternative program if you have a compelling academic reason and strong support of your major advisor(s). **Retroactive petitions will not be accepted.**
