The Program Agreement, issued to each student in November, will clarify the actual amounts that will be charged. Spring charges are posted to the student's WU account in November.

The following items will be billed through the student's WU account and paid to WU.

WU Tuition	\$18,900.00	WU tuition covers only the educational costs associated with a study abroad program.
WU Health Insurance	\$275.00	WU automatically enrolls full-time undergraduate students, including those studying abroad, in the WU student health insurance plan. Participation can not be waived. For more information visit the WU SHS website at http://shs.wustl.edu/insurance.htm
WU Program Price	\$19,175.00	

Housing, meals, Residence Permit and airfare are NOT included in the WU program price.

Housing: The student will be responsible for paying for his/her housing fees directly to a Dutch landlord or accommodation service. Housing applications and payment specifics will be communicated directly to the student by Utrecht University. Utrecht University estimates that housing will cost the student 400 euros per month (approximately \$528 US per month). Each student should also budget an additional 450 to 600 euros per month for food, books, transportation and personal expenses (approximately \$600 to \$800 US per month).

Residence Permit: Students must apply for a Residence Permit upon arrival in The Netherlands. Utrecht University organizes a special registration day in September for all exchange students. The Residence Permit is 433 euros (approximately \$570 US).

Airfare: The actual cost of airfare for each student depends upon many factors. It is estimated that airfare will cost \$900 - \$1,200. Obviously factors such as departure dates, locations and air carrier will affect the actual cost of airfare for each student.

Individual expenses may vary due to individual spending habits.
