Dear Globe Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in Washington University & Globe Education's annual summer program at **Shakespeare's Globe** in London. The dates for this summer's program are July 7 to August 1, 2008.

This year's application deadline is February 1. We encourage you to begin the application process promptly. In order to process your materials carefully and efficiently as possible, we will need for you to complete a number of forms. All materials should be returned to Washington University, Performing Arts Department, Globe Theatre Program, Campus Box 1108, One Brookings Drive, St. Louis, MO 63130.

All applications must include the following:

Data Sheet

Photocopy of Passport and two passport-size photographs – (if you are not currently in possession of a passport, this deadline can be moved to coincide with the deposit due date of March 15.)

Short Statement of Purpose. This should explain why the applicant wishes to attend the Globe Theatre summer program. We do not expect a long essay here; one or two paragraphs is sufficient.

Official transcript, sent directly from the Registrar to the Performing Arts Department.

Two letters of reference. We suggest asking faculty members or professionals who know you and your work. You can tell your recommenders that short, directed letters are preferred to long ones.


Signed Statement of Personal Responsibility and Assumption of Risk

The cost of the four week program is \$5000. This includes six units of Washington University academic credit; all classes, workshops, and master classes; accommodations with breakfast; theatre tickets to seven productions, and an excursion to Stratford-upon-Avon. It does not include airfare, local transportation, other meals and miscellaneous expenses.

Washington University students in good standing who wish to be considered for the Frank F. Fowle III London Theatre Scholarship should complete a scholarship application form available in the Performing Arts Department Office. Scholarship awards will be made separately from announcements of admission to the program.
